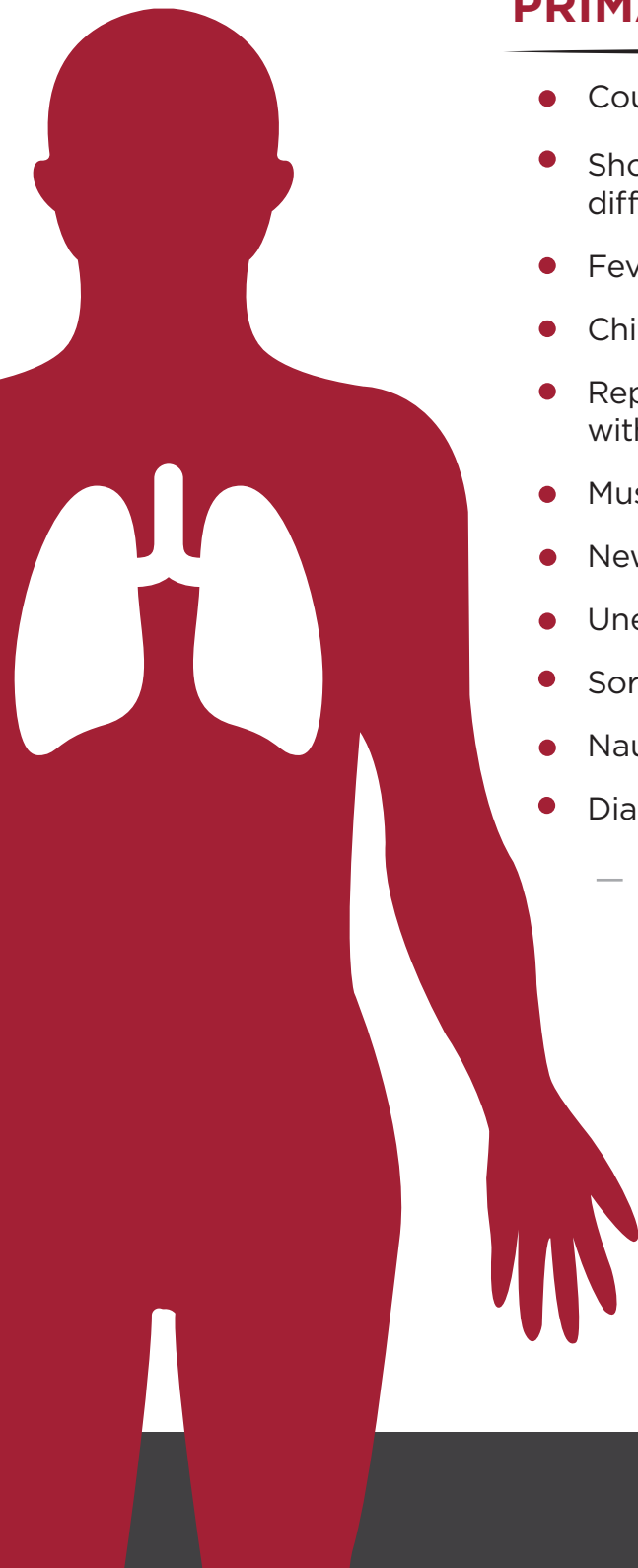




KNOW THE SYMPTOMS

COVID-19 is a new coronavirus that has been identified as the cause of an outbreak of respiratory illness globally.



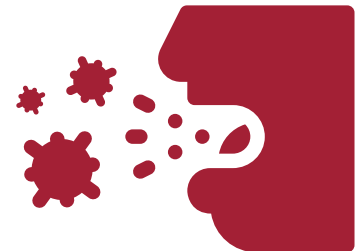
PRIMARY SYMPTOMS

- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fever
- Chills
- Repeated shaking with chills
- Muscle pain or body aches
- New loss of taste or smell
- Unexplained headache*
- Sore throat*
- Nausea*
- Diarrhea*

TRANSMISSION

Spread from person to person through sneezing or coughing.

Respiratory droplets containing the virus can remain on surfaces even after the ill person is no longer near.



SEVERE SYMPTOMS

- Trouble breathing
- Bluish lips or face
- Persistent pain or pressure in the chest
- New confusion or inability to arouse
